Protection Order Problem

Problems with Protection Order File

Since October 1998, the CJIS Audit Unit (CAU) has conducted POF audits as a part of their biennial

audit process to ascertain the VALIDITY, ACCURACY & COMPLETENESS of data found in POF entries.



Purpose Helps prevent acts of domestic violence.



Helps prevent one person from stalking, intimidating, or harassing another person.



Entry Access – Who May Enter?

Any criminal justice agency who:



has a "Full Access" Originating Agency Identifier (ORI); & can comply with NCIC's 24 Hour Hit Confirmation Policy. Includes civil and criminal courts depending upon the state.



Criteria for Entry To be entered into NCIC The Protection Order (PO) must meet the following Criteria:

1. The PO (including any injunction, restraining order, or any other order) issued by a civil or criminal court for the purpose of preventing violent or threatening acts or harassment against, sexual violence or contact or communication with or physical proximity to another person. (Continued)



Criteria for Entry

1. This includes temporary and final orders issued by a civil or criminal courts whether obtained by filing an independent action or as a pendente lite order in another proceeding so long as any civil order was issued in response to a complaint, petition, or motion filed by or on behalf of a person seeking protection. AND



Criteria for Entry

1. Any support, child custody or visitation provisions, orders, remedies, or relief issued as part of a protection order, restraining order, or stay away injunction pursuant to local, state, tribal, or territorial law authorizing the issuance of protection orders, restraining orders, or injunctions for the protection of victims of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking.



Criteria for Entry

2. Additionally, reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard must be given to the person against whom the order is sought; or, in the case of ex parte orders*, notice and opportunity to be heard must be provided within the time required by state laws, and in any event within reasonable time after the order is issued, sufficient to protect the respondent's due process rights.



Criteria for Entry - Definitions

- 1. Pendente Lite During the proceeding or litigation; in a manner contingent on the outcome of litigation. (Black's Law Dictionary, 8th ed. 2004)
- 2. Ex Parte* Done or made at the instance and for the benefit of one party only, and without notice to, or argument by, any person adversely interested; of or relating to court action taken by one party without notice to the other, usu. for temporary or emergency relief. (Black's Law Dictionary, 8th ed. 2004)

^{*} Ex Parte Orders should be entered as Temporary Protection Orders



Criteria for Entry

3. A Military Protective Order (MPO) that serves the same general purpose of a court-issued protection order issued in a civilian court qualifies for entry. An MPO is issued by a commissioned officer as a lawful order under Title 10, United States Code (U.S.C.), Article 90, Assaulting or willfully disobeying superior commissioned officer, of the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ 10 [U.S.C. Chapter 47]).

Retention Period

1. A POF record (EPO or ETO) will remain active until it is canceled or cleared by the entering agency or until the order expires. Five days prior to an order's expiration date, an unsolicited \$.P. administrative message will be sent to the ORI of record. This message will serve to notify the agency of the order's impending expiration date (EXP). It also

serves to remind the agency that the record will have to be modified if the EXP is changed by the court.



Retention Period

2. If no action is taken by the entering agency to modify the EXP, the record will expire after the fifth day. Inactive records (cleared or expired) will be maintained on-line for the remainder of the year plus 5 years. At the end of that time, NCIC will not notify the ORI of record.

Records that are in inactive status cannot be modified or cleared; however, inactive records can be canceled.



Retention Period

- 3. Nonexpiring Records: Records for protection orders that have no expiration are referred to as nonexpiring records (NONEXP). These records will remain active until cleared or canceled by the entering agency.
- 4. Inactive Records: Inactive records (expired or cleared) will be accessible, via the QPO message, for the remainder of the year in which the record was cleared or expired plus 5 years.



Retention Period

Registration Plates contained in a Protection Order File (POF) record (base or supplemental)

will remain as a part of the record after they officially expire for the remainder of the year, they expired + four additional years.





Validation

Validation is a process which ensures records entered by an agency into NCIC remain complete, accurate, and still outstanding or active.

Validation for a POF record is accomplished by reviewing the original entry and current supporting documents to ensure all available information is entered/accurate and by recent consultation with any appropriate court to ensure the PO is still active.

inquiry into the PO File (QPO) is made all ACTIVE, INACTIVE, and EXPIRED (last 5 years), records are returned.





Search Parameters – Search Methods

3. By using a QW or a QPO query a search of the Protected Persons

Name and Date of Birth (providing these were entered in the base record).





Search Parameters - Search Methods

- 4. NCIC (NIC) Number
- 5. Name (NAM) & PO Number (PNO) Requires exact match on name (spelling) to hit.
- 6. NAM and Originating Agency Case Number (OCA)
 - Requires exact match on name (spelling) to hit.



Search Parameters – Search Methods

7. NAM and any one of the following:

FBI Number (FBI)

Miscellaneous Number (MNU)

Social Security Number (SOC)

Operators License Number (OLN)

None of the above (1-4) combinations will generate a name search. In these situations, only the alphanumeric identifier is searched.



Search Parameters

An Algorithm is used in the name (NAM), alias (AKA), and protected person's name (PPN) fields of the person files. Which accounts for the different types of responses you receive back from the NCIC Computer.



Search Parameters

When the inquiry includes both the Name and DOB, hits are determined by using a phonetic encoding (Algorithm) of the

last name, (if common last name first initial is also used) and an exact match on the input month and day of birth.





Search Parameters

An Inquiry using the DOB of 19590110 will be searched:

19590110 19580110 19600110

When an individual is known to use more than one DOB the person's name should be checked using each DOB.





Search Parameters

If the input first name corresponds to a list of NCIC 2000 nicknames, it is replaced by a corresponding proper name for search purposes.

Bill is replaced with William

Betty is replaced with Elizabeth



Search Parameters

Searches two silent letters which are prevalent in the English Language.

Examples

When "Knowles" is inquired upon, Knowles" and "Nowles" is searched.

When "Wright" is inquired upon, "Wright" and "Right" is searched.

Search Parameters - Race

When inquiring using a specific race code it will limit your search. Race will be searched as follows:

Asian or Pacific Islander - All

American Indian - Alaskan Native - All

Black - All Except W

White - All Except B

Unknown - All

When there is any question as to race of the individual always use "Unknown".



Search Parameters - Gender

When inquiring using a specific sex code it will limit your search. Sex will be searched as follows:

Male

- Male

Female

- Female

Unknown

- Male or Female



Search Parameters - General

A "Hit Response" which contains a Social Security Number, FBI Number, or a Vehicle Identification Number, which was not part of the original search criteria will automatically generate an NCIC search on that specific number and return any results. Additionally, it provides any records linked through Linkage Agency Identifier (LKI) and Linkage Case Number (LKA) Fields.



Search Parameters - General



When a suspect is determined to have used fraudulent names and/or dates of birth each should be checked in all possible combinations.



Search Parameters - General

If the input last name contains a hyphen (-) primary hits are determined by using all combinations of the name parts.

Example - Saenz-Parada-Lopez

- 1. Saenz-Parada-Lopez
- 3. Lopez-Parada-Saenz
- 5. Parada-Lopez-Saenz
- 7. Saenz
- 9. Lopez

- 2. Saenz-Lopez-Parada
- 4. Lopez-Saenz-Parada
- 6. Parada-Saenz-Lopez
- 8. Parada



Search Parameters – Expanded Date of Birth Search

When an inquiry transaction includes the numeric "1" in the Expanded Date of Birth Search Field (EBS), the expanded date of birth search will return records with an exact input DOB as well as records with the exact month and day and a range of plus or minus one year of the input DOB.



Search Parameters – Expanded Date of Birth Search

NCIC provides the Expanded Name Search (ENS) field. When set to "Y" the system will search names as combinations.

Bryan Lee Morgan would be searched:

- 1. Lee Morgan Bryan 2. Morgan Lee Bryan
- 3. Lee Bryan Morgan 4. Bryan Lee Morgan
- 5. Morgan Bryan Lee 6. Bryan Morgan Lee



Hit Response – Hit Response

The entering agency must be able to confirm the status and terms of a protection order to any criminal justice agency that makes any inquiry.

If the entering agency does not operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week, it must have in place with another agency who does, a written agreement to provide responses to those agencies who request the status or terms of a Protection Order.



Hit Response - Caution and Medical Indicators (CMC)

Any CMC's which are entered for the subject of the Protection Order will cause them to be printed at the top of the "Hit Response" after the Message Key (MKE). Additionally, they should be further explained in the Miscellaneous Field.



Hit Response - Caution and Medical Indicators (CMC)

Hit Response - Brady Indicator

Protection Orders meeting certain criteria disqualify an individual from possessing,

purchasing, or receiving a firearm per 18 USC 922.





Hit Response - Brady Indicator

Special Note: There is no requirement that a court formally make a Brady Indicator status determination during the proceeding. An entering agency can make this determination if all the requirements were met during the proceeding and the file contains the necessary information as it relates to these requirements.



Hit Response - Brady Indicator

Pursuant to Federal law the Brady Indicator requires one of the three* following responses:

1. Y=Yes, the subject is Brady Disqualified.

Actually Means

No, the subject cannot receive or possess a firearm.



Hit Response - Brady Indicator

The Brady Indicator requires one of the three following responses:

2. N=No, the subject is "not Brady Disqualified" (Actually Means)

Yes, the subject can receive or possess a firearm



Hit Response - Brady Indicator

The Brady Indicator requires one of the three following responses:

3. U=Unknown - Used if a court did not meet the criteria defined by statute to determine if the subject of the protection order is prohibited from shipping, transporting, possessing or receiving a firearm.



Hit Response - Brady Indicator

Only a final protection order can contain a Brady Indicator of "Y" or "U"*.

Emergency or temporary orders issued ex parte do not meet the specified requirements thus a "N" must be entered for these type orders.



Hit Response - Brady Indicator

Prior to entering a record, an entering agency should make every attempt to determine the firearm disqualification status.

The "U"* Code should only be made when it is impossible to make that determination.



Hit Response - Brady Indicator To be able to place "Y" in the Brady Field the following elements must be met.

1. It must be a qualifying PO order that restrains an individual from harassing, stalking, threatening, or engaging in other conduct that would place an intimate partner in reasonable fear of bodily injury to the partner, or a child of the partner disqualifies that individual from possessing, purchasing, or receiving a firearm providing that the order:



Hit Response - Brady Indicator

To be able to place "Y" in the Brady Field the following elements must be met.

2. Was issued after a hearing, of which the subject received actual notice, and at which such person had an opportunity to participate, and;



Hit Response - Brady Indicator

- 3. Includes a finding that the subject represents a credible threat to the physical safety of an intimate partner or child.
- 4. Explicitly prohibits the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical force against an intimate partner or child that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury.



Hit Response - Brady Indicator

When "Y" is placed in the Brady Indicator Field it will generate the following caveat.

- 3. Prohibited under Both Federal and State Law from Possessing Firearms.
- 4. Not Prohibited by Either.



Hit Confirmation



Any agency which receives a record(s) in response to an NCIC inquiry must confirm the hit on any record which appears to have been entered for the person inquired upon prior to arresting or charging the subject.



Hit Confirmation

Confirming a hit means to contact the agency which entered the record to:

- 1. Ensure the person inquired upon is identical to the person in the record;
- 2. Ensure that the warrant, missing person report, protection order is still outstanding; and



Hit Confirmation

- 3. Obtain a decision regarding
 - A. Extradition (if Applicable)
 - B. Information regarding the missing person (if applicable)
 - C. Information regarding the terms, conditions, and service of the PO.

Hit Response - Brady Indicator To be able to place "Y" in the Brady Field the following elements must be met.

1. It must be a qualifying PO order that restrains an individual from harassing, stalking, threatening, or engaging in other conduct that would place an <u>intimate partner</u> in reasonable fear of bodily injury to the partner, or a child of the partner disqualifies that individual from possessing, purchasing, or receiving a firearm providing that the order:



Hit Response - Brady Indicator

- 3. Includes a finding that the subject represents a credible threat to the physical safety of an intimate partner or child.
- 4. Explicitly prohibits the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical force against an <u>intimate</u> partner or child that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury.

Brady Indicator BIF

The federal firearm prohibition does not apply unless the relationship between the subject of a protection order (respondent) and the protected person (petitioner) is that of an intimate partner or child of an intimate partner.

Brady Indicator BIF

Intimate Partner--with respect to a person, the spouse of the person, a former spouse of the person, an individual who is a parent of a child of the person, and an individual who cohabit or has cohabited with the person.

Optional Fields

Brady Indicator BIF

Cohabitation--requires a live-in relationship (or former live-in relationship) between two (2) individuals (can be same sex) which, in essence, is a sexual/romantic relationship, NOT merely a roommate.

Although not a mandatory field the Protected Person(s) Name (PPN), and when available the Protected Person(s) Date of Birth (PPB), should be included in the record so that an inquiry of the Wanted Persons File using the protected persons identifiers would reveal the POF record.

POF Entry

The POF has file specific guidelines which must be adhered to.

- 2. Date of Expiration (EXP)
 - A. If the PO has no expiration date "Non-Expiring" (NONEXP) should be entered.
 - B. If the PO is a temporary order, it can have any expiration date up to and including a "non-expiring" expiration date.



POF Entry

Miscellaneous Field (MIS)

Any caution indicator used in the message key and/or caution/medical indicators should be explained in the MIS.

Nicknames should be placed in the MIS Field and not the Alias Field (AKA).



POF Entry

Miscellaneous Field (MIS) (Continued)

Any agency which uses protection order condition "08" must fully explain it in the MIS Field.



POF Entry

Miscellaneous Field (MIS)

The Miscellaneous Field should be used to fully explain any condition necessary.

Example - 01 The subject is restrained from assaulting, threatening, abusing, harassing, following, interfering with, or stalking the protected person and/or the child of the protected person. Additional Information which was part of the PO is added to the MIS Field.

POF Validation

In the event the ORI is unsuccessful in conducting a proper validation the entering authority must make a determination based on the best information and knowledge available whether or not to retain the original entry in the file.



POF Cancellation

Protection Order File Records that have been expunged or are determined to be inaccurate should be canceled.

Active, expired, and cleared records can be canceled.



POF Cancellation

A cancellation immediately retires a POF

record thus these records are not

available in the inactive database.
