Further Detail of Potential Responses to Identified Concerns:

AS TO THE OFFENDING PARENT:

Limit access to the adult victim

- ☐ Ask the offending parent to leave the shared residence
- ☐ Initiate no contact provisions for duration of parenting plan
- ☐ Monitor no contact orders

Limit access to the child

- ☐ Ask the offending parent to leave the shared residence
- ☐ Initiate no contact provisions for duration of parenting plan
- ☐ Recommend supervised visitation at the Parenting Place (608-784-8125)
- ☐ Recommend suspended visitation

Restrict communication with the adult victim

- ☐ Limit methods of communication
- ☐ Prescribe frequency and methods of communication
- ☐ Restrict length and/or content of communication
- ☐ Limit access to sensitive communication

Refer to remedial interventions and/or services

- ☐ Licensed BIPPS program (in-person or online)
- ☐ Parenting after violence program (in-person or online)
- ☐ Parenting classes at the Parenting Place (608-784-8125)

Monitor compliance with court orders

- ☐ Conditions of bond
